

said negro girl Rachelle & her increase, and the said Tract of plantation or parcel of land and its
 appurtenances, unto the said William Edwards, his heirs executors administrators or assigns forever, provided
 nevertheless, in and to the special Trust and confidence, and for no other intent or purpose,
 whatsoever, that should the said Samuel Vick his heirs executors or assigns fail to pay or
 cause to be paid unto the said John Plague his heirs executors administrators or assigns the first
 before mentioned bond of thirty five pounds, at or before it shall become due as aforesaid
 that then it shall and may be lawful to and for the said William Edwards his heirs
 executors or administrators to sell the said negro girl Rachelle and her increase at public sale
 at Savannah on a Court day, for the best price that can be had of Slaves for her
 or them in any manner, forth abating such sale for one month at the Court
 house door of the said County, and also all the then Towing of Slaves in Savannah, & out
 of the money arising from sale to pay and satisfy unto the said John Plague his heirs executors administrators
 or assigns the amounts of the first said bond and interest, (if any) and also to pay all such costs and
 charges as may happen or arising concerning the same, and the overplus (if any) to be paid unto
 or them, to be put out upon the best interest that can be had for the same subject
 to the payment of the second bond before mentioned, and if the said bond before mentioned
 of twenty pounds, shall not be wholly or fully paid by the said Samuel Vick his heirs
 executors administrators or assigns unto the said John Plague his heirs executors administrators or assigns, at or before the same
 shall become due as aforesaid, that then it shall & may be lawful to & for the said William
 Edwards his heirs executors or administrators to sell at public sale for as many of the said
 tract of plantation or parcel of land, and its appurtenances, or so much thereof as shall be sufficient
 to the raising and fully paying the whole or balance of the said second bond and the interest
 thereof (if any) and to pay also all such costs or charges as may happen or arise concerning the
 same, but in the first place the value of the money arising upon the sale of the said
 negro girl Rachelle & her increase is to be applied that way (if any) first abating
 the sale of the said land for the same length of time, and in the same manner as is mentioned
 upon sale of the said negro, and to be sold on the premises, and in Porters Key, to make
 a legal & lawful conveyance of the said land & its appurtenances inasmuch as shall be
 necessary thereof to be sold, to the purchaser or purchasers in fee simple; and the profits
 arising from such sale (if any) to be returned unto the said Samuel Vick his heirs executors administrators
 or assigns when demanded, and it is agreed by and between the said parties further, that the said
 Samuel Vick his heirs executors or administrators is to remain in possession of the said negro girl
 Rachelle and also of the said tract of land & plantation until the expiration of the said five
 or three is to take place & to enjoy the same fully, and the said Samuel Vick for
 himself his heirs executors & administrators the hereby, bargain & sell premises unto the said
 William Edwards, his heirs executors or administrators, shall & will warrant & defend
 & defend for the purposes aforesaid in law, and for no other intent or purpose whatsoever
 these presents against the lawful claim of all and every person or persons whatsoever
 or whomsoever, in M. W. J. whereof the parties to these presents have consented
