

This Indenture, made the 14th day of March 1817, between Henry Pelworth of the County of Norfolk of the one part & his Executors of the County of Southampton of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Henry Pelworth for & in consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds good & lawful money of Virginia's already in hand paid by the said John Garrawe the receipt of which I sum the said Henry Pelworth doth hereby acknowledge himself fully & entirely satisfied have bargained sold sold over & delivered unto the said John Garrawe all those premises as hereinafter set out & delivered unto the said John Garrawe and of sign for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Norfolk situate being all the Land & plantation given and by my father Robert Pelworth excepting fifteen yards square for the grave yard the said tract or parcel of land containing twenty five acres more or less, together with all and singular the land tenements profits emoluments & hereditaments therein or thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining & all & singular the revenues & advantages, remaines & terminable sale & singular the estate right title interest claim & demands of them the said Henry Pelworth & his wife, their heirs & assigns forever, to have and to hold the said bargained premises to the said John Garrawe his heirs & assigns forever & to the only proper and lawful & lawful heirs of him the said John Garrawe forever & the said Henry Pelworth & his wife for themselves & their heirs the said parcel of Land with all the appurtenances abovesaid and every part thereof against them and their heirs & against all & every other person or persons whatsoever the said Henry Pelworth & his wife their heirs & assigns shall & lawfully warrant & forever defend by this present.
