This Indenture made this 31st day of March, in the year of our Lord 1807, between John Pogue Sen and duly his wife of the one part, and Isaiah Wick of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said John Pogue Sen being his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & twenty four pounds current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid by the said Isaiah Wick the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John, that the said John Pogue Sen & duly his wife hath given, bargained sold, aliened, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth hereby bargain, sell, alien, release & confirm unto the said Isaiah Wick his heirs and assigns, one certain tract, plantation or parcel of land lying and being situate in the said County of Southampton in Middleby parish, adjoining the lands of Capt. A. Harrington Sen, Lazarus (late a Father Pope), the lands belonging to the estate of Charles Spence dec^d, and the said Isaiah Wick containing by estimation one hundred & twenty
