

This Indenture, made May the 18th 1807 between Jacob Wick
 of the part & William Ferguson of the other part, each of the County of Southampton
 Virginia that the said Jacob Wick for & in consideration of the sum of two
 hundred & twenty five dollars lawful money of Virginia, granted & conveyed
 to the said William Ferguson, twenty five acres of land which is a corner
 plantation, bounded as follows, beginning at a pole near a meeting house, thence
 south forty six pole, thence West twenty two pole, thence north ten poles
 thence one hundred pole, thence north east one hundred & fourteen pole, thence south
 east sixty four pole, thence to the beginning, together with all the appurtenances
 belonging to the said land unto the said William Ferguson, his heirs and assigns

This Indenture, made the 18th day of May 1807 Between
 Drury Mader & Mary his wife of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the
 one part and Moses Evans of the aforesaid County & State of the other part, Witnesseth that
 whereas the aforesaid Drury Mader for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars
 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the aforesaid Moses Evans the receipt
 whereof, he hath hereby acknowledged, hath granted conveyed, sold, aliened, released, conveyed
 and by these presents for himself, his heirs, with grant, bargain, sell, alien, release and
 conveyance unto the said Moses Evans, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain parcel of land
 lying being & situate in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows, beginning
 at the road joining between Thomas Lane, thence along the said Lane to the said
 Mader Lane, thence along the said Mader Lane to the corner, from thence to the
 said road, and along the said road to the beginning, containing one acre, with all houses
 wood, vine, water courses thereto, belonging unto the same, and every part thereof of the
 aforesaid acre of land, to have and to hold, the said granted land with the appurtenances
 to the said Moses Evans and his heirs & assigns, that he, Mader at all times, hereafter, peacefully
 & quietly holds & enjoy the said granted land, out free from all other persons, debts
 suits, mortgages, rights of action or any other incumbrance whatsoever and that the said
 Drury Mader, his heirs and assigns shall Warrant & defend the said granted land
 and premises unto the said Moses Evans, his heirs and assigns forever against all
 persons whatsoever that shall lay claim thereto, In Witness whereof the
