This Indenture made this 8th day of December in the year of Christ eight hundred and five, between Joel Robertson, Nicholas Robertson & Mary Robertson his wife, all of the County of Southampton of the one part, & Lewis Morrill of the same County on the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred shillings to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrill before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargain & sold and by these presents do & each of them do grant, bargain, sell, alien & confirm unto him the said Lewis Morrill his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, claim, property & interest which they the said Joel Robertson, Nicholas Robertson and Mary his wife, her, or hereafter may have in & to a certain tract of land lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & bounded by the well known line, and being the same tract of land conveyed unto said Joel Robertson & Nicholas Robertson by Francis Robertson their father, in a gift deed bearing date the 18th day of October 1802, which said deed of gift stands recorded in the County Court of Southampton to have and to hold, the said tract of land with its boundaries together with the premises and all and every of the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Lewis Morrill his heirs & assigns forever, and they the said Joel Robertson, Nicholas Robertson, & Mary his wife and each of them for themselves and each of their heirs representatives as by these presents more at large is expressed, all rights, profits and interests in & to the said land the premises & appurtenances unto him the said Lewis Morrill his heirs and representatives forever, An testimony of all which they the said Joel Robertson, Nicholas Robertson & Mary his wife, have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day year and point above written.
