

This Indenture, made the sixth day of March 1807, between
Isaac Browne of Southampton County of the one part and *Francis E. Walker* of
 Middlebury County of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said *Isaac Browne* in and
 to the said *Francis E. Walker* has secured the payment of five hundred pounds, said *Richard M. Walker* of said
 County by him, pay all the first day of January last, and in consideration, of the
 sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said *Francis E. Walker* at or before
 the making and delivery of these presents the master whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said *Isaac Browne*, both granted, bargained and sold and by these presents, with
 grant bargain and sell unto the said *Francis E. Walker* the following slaves, *Isaac*
Dick, *Ralph*, *Emmanuel*, *Meads*, *Lockson* and *Daniel*, then and their future increase,
 We have and to hold, the above mentioned property and their future increase unto the said
Francis E. Walker, his heirs, Executors and assigns forever, Upon trust, notwithstanding
 that the said *Francis E. Walker* shall after giving thirty days notice to be advertised
 in some public Newspaper published in Middlebury, proceed to sell the same to the
 highest bidder for the best price that can be obtained, and out of the money arising from
 the sale in the first place to satisfy and pay the debt above mentioned and to pay all
 charges attending such sale, and the residue of the money arising from such sale
 is to be paid to the said *Isaac Browne*, his heirs, Executors and assigns, who of the parties has
 hereunto set their hands, Seal and this day, 6 year first above written
