

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of March in the year of our Lord 1806
 between Richard Blackshin and Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton
 of the one part and Joseph Wilson of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 Richard Blackshin and Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty six shillings
 money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or about the making of these presents the receipt
 whereof they do here by acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid have here-
 unto aliened and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto Joseph Wilson his heirs
 and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of
 containing by estimation nine acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
 beginning at a Sassafig in Elias Prays line standing at the side of a damme thence along
 a line of marked trees to a cypress station a corner in Richard Blackshin's line thence along
 a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree in William Laurence's line thence along a line
 of marked trees to a Maple a corner tree in a small Branch in Ray's Wilson's line thence
 up the said Branch to the first station the said Plantations tract or parcel of land to them
 and proper use and behoof the said Joseph Wilson his heirs Exors. and assigns forever
 with all houses out houses, Cellars, buildings yards, gardens, orchards and all profits thereto then
 claim or demand to him the said Joseph Wilson and the said Richard Blackshin with Lucy
 his wife shall and will warrant and for ever defend the said Plantations tract or parcel
 of land unto the said Joseph Wilson his heirs Exors. and assigns against the title of
 any person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof
 with Reversion and Reversions remainders or remainders whatsoever in witness whereof the said
 Richard Blackshin and Lucy his wife hath hereunto set their hands and seals this day
 year above written —
