

Southampton (cont'd to write)

In Obedience to the aforesaid commission we have this present day personally
seen and the witness named Lucy Pleyer wife of the within named John Pleyer
who privately and apart from her said husband acknowledged the voluntary signing
and sealing of the within deed, that she is the same without her husband or
knowing of the said husband, and that she is willing the within deed shall be
only recorded in the said County Court of Southampton, giving witness whereunto
and seals this 16th day of March 1804 -

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 23rd day of July 1804
This indenture was made by the acts of Samuel Calvert & Samuel Hallett
and Elizabeth Barnes their wife of the witness hereunto and with a Commission for
the just examination of Mr. Pleyer and certifices of his written return
is now sent to the Board.

This Indenture made this 1st day of July in the year of
our Lord Christ 1804 between Purley Barret of the parish of Netley in the
County of Southampton and Susanna Barret his wife of the one part and Joseph
Deman of the same parish and County of the other part, M^r Deman that the said
Purley Barret & Susanna his wife for and in consideration of the sum of ninety
pounds to which to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Deman the
receipt whereof the said Purley Barret with kindly acknowledgements have and each of
them both and by these presents do and each of them with grants, bargains and
aliens released and confirmed unto the said Joseph Deman and to his heirs and assigns
having all that plantation, improvement tract and piece of land aforesaid with the
appurtenances thereunto lying and being in the parish of Netley and County of
Southampton late in the tenure and occupation of the said Purley Barret con-
taining by estimation thirty five thousand acres, to the same more or less by boundary
or points to wit beginning at a small pine standing on the path that leads to William
et alii's mill (now a ruin) of Joseph Deman's and Purley Barret's running thence
north eighty three degrees west, sixteen pole to a red oak in Joseph Deman's
lawn, thence north sixty degrees west thirty five pole to a red oak in the same lawn
thence north fifty six degrees west, twenty eight pole to a pinkie pine in the
same lawn, thence north forty one degrees west fourteen pole, thence north
fifty degrees west twenty four pole, thence north forty two degrees west
one hundred & thirty nine half pole to a black pine standing in a small branch
