This Indenture made this 10th day of July in the year of our Lord
1804 between William Washington (of Deed) in the County of Southampton
of the one part and Nathan Fort of the County of Southampton of the other part
Witnesseth that whereas the said William Washington stands indebted to John
Quatony surviving partner of Ruffin & Quatony formerly residents of Boston
in New England in the just and full sum of Eighty four pounds thirteen shillings
and eight pence — now on demand, and being willing and desirous to secure
to him the payment of the same or to his heirs or assigns the said John Quatony
has hereby made to the said Fort brother one negotiable by the name
