Know all men by these presents, that I give the following property, to my grand son Joshua Gurnard to wit, one red & white cow one red and white little yearling, and six white marked with a swastika fork in each ear, I also give to my grand son John Gurnard, one red buckskin pig one case and one red heifer, also six white marked with a swastika fork in each ear, I also give to my grand daughter Patsy Gurnard one feather bed and furniture one round table, one chest, one spinning wheel and cards, to wit, 1 to three brass & a finger ring, the right and title I will warrant & defend against all persons claiming or demanding the same, Witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of October 1803—
