This Indenture made this 7th day of March, in the year four 1817
 Between Edwin Turner of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one
 part and Archibald Parker of superior County and aforesaid State of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Edwin Turner for and in consideration of the sum of
 one hundred fifteen pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid
 on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof of the
 said Edwin Turner, with hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained and sold
 aliened and confirmed unto the said Archibald Parker and taken him and assigns
 for ever, one hundred fifty seven and a half acres, siting part of a tract of land late
 the property of Arthur Turner and adjoining the land whereon said Turner
 remained from and bound as follows, to wit, beginning at a ^{square} ^{corner} ^{point} ^{marked}
 between Archibald Parker and Edwin Turner, thence with 26th acres east 186th feet
 a large pine in parker lane, thence south 19 acres east 4 poles to a small
 black gum standing in the bush land branch a corner of Benjamin Johnson's land
 Parker thence south 4th 8 poles to 49 poles on the side of the said black gum
 swamp, thence the 49 poles corner of the said swamp 44 poles to a pine a corner
 of Edwin Turner & Benjamin Johnson, thence with 51st 8 poles 100 poles to a
 light house post, a corner of Edwin Turner & Archibald Parker, thence with
 31st 8 poles to the first station - containing one hundred & fifty seven
 and a half acres more or less, to have and to hold the said one hundred and fifty seven
 and a half acres with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging to the said Archibald
