

324 This Indenture, made this 17th day of August in the year
Moore and Lane about 1807. Between Benjamin Jones of the County of Southampton
to and parish of, Netley of the one part and Catty Woodward of the same County
and parish aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Catty Woodward
for an Summation of the sum of twenty two pounds & 12^d. to her in
hand paid by the said Benjamin Jones, the receipt whereof the said Catty
Woodward doth hereby acknowledge, has up fully & amply satisfied and paid
hath hereby agreed, and by these presents doth agree bargain sell alien & assign
unto the said Benj. Jones all my rights and titles claim or demand of the land whereon
I value Mining and formerly laid, which land was sold by Arthur Sayer to the said
Benj. Jones of which the said Sayer was a legatee and the said Catty Woodward being
entitled to one eighth part of the said land to which I the said Catty Woodward do
hereby relinquish and give up all my rights and titles of the said land unto the
said Benjamin Jones and his heirs forever, with all houses out houses Cisterns
buildings yards gardens orchards ways water & water courses belonging or in anywise
appertaining to the said land, to have and to hold all the said part of land pro-
prietarily belonging to Catty Woodward unto the said Benj. Jones to him & to his heirs
forever, and I the said Catty Woodward do defend all rights & titles claim or demand
of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcels
