1805, between Reuben Whitfield of Southampton County, Virginia of the one part
and John Lee of the same County & State of the other part, Mathew Weston and
Jeremiah Doyles in and to secure the payment of a debt due from
to & for the said Reuben Whitfield to Jacob Denson sum of Mills County debts
July 1808 as appears by his hands received of the said Administration bearing equal date
with these presents for the sum of four hundred & nineteen dollars 88 cts
and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid at & before the making hereof
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Reuben
Whitfield hath granted bargain sold & by these presents with grant bargain
sell unto the said John Lee all that tract or parcels of land which he the
said Reuben Whitfield purchased from Abington Sons of George & being situated
