This Indenture made this sixth day of February one thousand eight hundred and seven between Thomas Porter and Lucy his wife of the one part and John Whitehead of the other part all of Southampton County, State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Thomas Porter & Lucy his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred and Ninety Dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Whitehead Granted bargain'd sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Whitehead, and to his heirs and assigns forever, one certain Tract or parcel of land situate and lying in the said county of Southampton and Beginning at a corner black gum in Appleton's branch and in said Whitehead's farm in line: then down said branch, or nearly so, to where it empties into Blunts Swamp then up the said Swamp the various corners to the mouth of Reese Swamp then up the said Swamp to the mouth of the big branch then up that branch to the mouth of the
