 fore give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the
 said Rebecca shall be willing to make before you of the foregoing

 Command you to go personally to the said Rebecca and examine her
 personally & apart from her said husband whether she hath executed
 the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or thra-
 ats of her husband whether she be willing the said Indenture should
 be recorded in the Court of our said County. And when you have examin-
 ed her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the same
 that you distinctly Certify us thereof under your hands and seals
 returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed
 witness Sam^l Killo clerk of our said Court at the House the 17th
 day of June 1807 and in 32nd year of our foundation
 Southampton S^r.

Agueable to the within Commission to us directed we
 have gone to the House of John Williams and privately examined
 M^{rs} Rebecca Williams, wife of the S^d John Williams, & apart from
 her husband whether she hath executed the S^d deed freely & volunta-
