This Indenture made this 28th day of November one thousand eight hundred and five between Richard Blunt of Southampton County and state of Virginia, as executor and by authority of the last will and Testament of John Kindred late of said County, deceased and Sally Kindred widow of the said John Kindred of said County, of the one part, and Benjamin Turner of the same County of the other part. - Witnesseth, that the said Richard Blunt, executor as aforesaid, and by the authority aforesaid, and the said Sally Kindred, widow of the said John Kindred, have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Benjamin Turner and his heirs and assigns forever, for and in consideration of the sum of the sum of five hundred and seventy nine pounds thirty shillings current money of Virginia, to him the said Richard Blunt as executor aforesaid in hand paid the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, one certain Tract or parcel of land situated in the said County of Southampton, containing three hundred & eighty two & 1/2 acres be the same more or less, reference being had to the plots of said Land the situation boundaries and quantity will fully and large appear, which plot is hereunto annexed as a part of this, To have and to hold the said three hundred & eighty two & 1/2 acres of land unto him the said Benjamin Turner his heirs & assigns forever with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any manner whatsoever appurtenant and the said Richard Blunt executor as aforesaid, and the said Sally Kindred widow as aforesaid, do hereby warrant and defend a peaceable and quiet possession of the said Land unto him the said Benjamin Turner his heirs and assigns forever, against the claim of her the said Sally widow as aforesaid her heirs or assigns or the heirs of the said John Kindred deceased.
