This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven. Between Edmund Tyler of the County of Southampton of the one part and Ethelard Vaper of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred Eighty Two dollars to him in hand paid by the said Ethelard Vaper the receipt whereof the said Edmund Tyler doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Ethelard Vaper his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred & sixty three and a half acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton on the South side of round Hill Swamp and bounded as follows Viz. beginning at a white oak in John Claytons line thence Mary Adams and Edward W. Tylers line to spine a corner tree in Henry Butts line thence the said Butts line to the head of Carters branch thence down the said branch to another oak in Samuel Jons line thence the said Jons line to spine in the head of a prong of the Middle branch thence down the said branch to round Hill Swamp thence up the said Swamp to John Claytons line and thence along his line to the beginning. To have and to hold the said parcel of land with the appurtenances unto the said Ethelard Vaper or his heirs together with all profits Commodities
