 shoud make default therein it is hereby agreed & intended to be
 the true intent and meaning of this Indenture that if the sd.
 sum of one hundred & twenty two pounds eight shillings &
 $\frac{1}{4}$ be not paid unto the sd. Henry Smith with all Interest
 thereon on or before the first day of May next then the said
 Smith shall be at liberty at any time thereafter when it
 may suit him the said debt or any part thereof still
 remaining unpaid to require & compel the said Newt Harris
 to sell the said tract of land and negroes at public sale for ready
 money on the premises and the said Newt Harris shall have
 full power and lawful authority to sell the same having
 previously advertised the time & place of sale at least ten
 days on the premises & two other publick places in the county
 convenient to the premises & the sd. Newt Harris shall have
 power and authority to convey & make over by Deed or Deeds in
 writing a lawful right and title to the purchaser or purchasers
 of sd. Negro & the said Wm. Vaughan his heirs & assigns
 shall be forever stopping from setting up any claim to
 the same either in law or equity & the money arising from
 such sale first to be applied to the payment of the said
 sum of one hundred & twenty two pounds eight shillings
 $\frac{1}{4}$ due the sd. Smith with all Interest and cost ensuing
