This Indenture made this 31st Day of August in the Year
 of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred & Seven
 Between Samuel Turner and Sally his wife of Southampton
 County of the one part and Eum Turner of the County aforesaid
 of the other part With witness That the said Saml. Turner
 of Virginia wife for and in consideration of the just and full
 Sum of Three hundred Dollars Current money of Virginia by
 the said Eum Turner to them in hand paid at or before the
 Enacting and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
 D^r. Samuel Turner & Sally his wife both hereby acknowledge themselves
 fully & amply satisfied and paid they the said Samuel Turner
 & Sally his wife have granted Bargained Sold Aliened set over
 and Delivered and by these presents do grant Bargain sell set over
 alien Release & Confirm unto the D^r. Eum Turner his heirs and
 assigns forever all that plantation messuage tract or parcel of
 Land Situate lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 and parish of Netoway containing by Estimation Sixty
 Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
 Beginning at an Ash standing at the mouth of the old
 Branch in Burnwell Williamss Lane thence up the run
 of D^r. Branch to a red oak standing in Lion Williamss
 Lane thence along D^r. Lane to and oak a corner tree standing at the
 head of a small branch thence down the run of D^r. Branch to a
 black gum a corner tree standing in the South prong of the
 Byppes Swamp thence down the swamp D^r. Swamp to a black
 Gum a corner tree standing in the fork of D^r. Swamp thence
