This Indenture made this fifteenth Day of August in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and seven between Reuben Whitefield of the county of Southampton of the one part & Joshua Fort of the same county of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas the said Reuben Whitefield stands indebted to John Wigham surviving partner of Ruffin and Wigham in the sum in full sum of one hundred and four pounds seven shillings & six pence now on demand; and being willing and desirous to secure to him the payment thereof or to his heirs or assigns the said Reuben Whitefield does hereby make over all that tract or parcel of land bought by him from James Brown lying and being in the aforesaid County adjoining the lands of Jeremiah Drake & John Thorp (called the Pompey land) containing two hundred and forty acres to the same more or less, In trust to the said Joshua Fort trustee for the parties aforesaid and in case the said Reuben Whitefield shall fail to pay to the said John Wigham the said sum of one hundred & four pounds seven shillings & six pence and lawful interest thereon on or before the twenty fifth day of December next then to shall be lawfull for the said J. Fort to advertise the said tract of land for sale and after due notice thereof to make sale of the same for cash or on credit as he the trustee
