This Indenture made between Michael Leonard of the county of Southampton on the one part and John Ganson & Martha his wife of the county of Surry on the other part, all of the State of Virginia - Witnesseth, That the said John Ganson & Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One five pounds to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have bargained & sold, by these presents, with bargain sell alien, release & confirm unto the aforesaid Michael Leonard one certain tract & parcel of land lying & being situated in the aforesaid county of Southampton and bounded as follows - Beginning twenty feet from the corner of the lot and lumberhouse formerly the property of the said Michael Leonard, and running seventy yards westwardly up the road leading to Bedford three Northwards one hundred yards to the east side of a stake three eastwardly seventy yards to a stake - thence Southwardly to the beginning on hundred yards containing one & a half acres more or less
