This Indenture made this 29th day of October in the year of our Lord 1804
One thousand Eight hundred and seven Between Thomas Senr. Benjⁿ
Lewis John Applewhite and Seth Nicholson Commissioners appointed by the
Court of Southampton County to see the said Marriage to the
Heirs of John Taylor Decd. all of the county of Southampton and parish
of St. Lukes of the one part and Thomas Fitzhugh Senr. of the other
part and parish of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Thomas
Neddy Senr. Benjamin Lewis John Applewhite & Seth Nicholson
Commissioners appointed as aforesaid for and in the consideration of the
sum of One hundred and fifty one pounds eight shillings and
six pence of Good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand
paid on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof we the said Thomas Neddy and Benjamin Lewis
John Applewhite and Seth Nicholson Commissioners appointed as aforesaid
do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened demised
conveyed into the said Thomas Fitzhugh Senr. and to his heirs and assigns
forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and
seventy nine and a half Acres of Land and bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a stake a corner of the Dower Land of the Widow of
Henry Taylor Decd. and Peter Odors Land thence along the said
