This Indenture made this 25 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eight Between Stephen Barham of the one part Samuel Wallace of the second part and Benjamin Cobb of the third part, all of the County of Southampton, Witnesseth that whereas the said Stephen Barham stands justly indebted to the said Samuel Wallace by a writing obligation under his & Seal bearing equal date with these presents in the sum of Eighty Seven dollars & fifty cents — an Debt and whereas for the further assurance & securing the payment aforesaid, it is agreed by the said Stephen Barham & Samuel Wallace that a Conveyance in Trust shall be made to the said Benjamin Cobb for the benefit of the said Samuel Wallace, Now This Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Stephen Barham do and in consideration of the promises aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents with for himself his heirs and assigns grant bargain & sell make over & Confirm unto the said Benjamin Cobb and to his heirs or assigns a certain lot or tenement of Land in the town of Gosport in the County of Southampton and whereas the said Stephen Barham now lives, To have and to hold the said Lot or tenement of Land, with all & singular the improvements thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, with the appurtenances unto him the said Benjamin Cobb his heirs & assigns, In Trust nevertheless and upon this express Condition, that if the said Stephen Barham his heirs or assigns shall or cause to be paid to the said
