This Indenture made this twenty first day of December in the year of
 our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and Seven between Howell Barham
 and Anne his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Peter Manry of the same County of the other part—
 Witnesseth that the Said Howell Barham and Anne his wife for
 and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to them in
 hand paid by the Said Peter Manry before the sealing and
 delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the Said Howell
 Barham and Anne his wife do hereby acknowledge and then
 selves satisfied hath given granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed
 and confirmed unto the said Peter Manry his heirs &c. forever one
 certain Tract or parcel of land containing forty acres be the same
 more or less in the County of Southampton and parish of St.
 Lukes and bounded as follows, to wit, — Beginning at the same
 Swamp at a corner of Live Rockelle and Said Lands thence
 along Rockelle line to a red oak a ferner thence eastward by
 marked trees to a lightwood post standing in an open field
 thence Northwardly by marked trees to a Sweet gum standing in
 a small branch thence a straight line to the narrow Swamp thence
 up the various courses of the Said Swamp to the beginning
 together with every part and parcel of Said Land as aforesaid and
 depend unto the said Peter Manry and his heirs forever the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of Land. In Witness whereof we have hereunto set
