This Indenture made this 23th day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and six Between John Myrick and Elizabeth
his wife of the County of Halifax State of North Carolina of the one
part; and David Myrick of the County of Southampton State of
Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that John Myrick and Elizabeth his
wife for and in consideration of one thousand and sixteen dollars in hand
paid by the said David Myrick at or before the unsealing of these pres-
ents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold, and
by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said
David Myrick his heirs and assigns one certain tract parcel or piece of
land lying and being in the said County of Southampton on the north
side of Mahan river containing by late survey one hundred and forty
Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth; Beginning at
a gum a corner tree in the said David Myrick other Lands John Harris
senr. lands and the said Lands - thence as long the said Harris line to
a corner stump dividing the said Lands sold by said John Myrick to
Harris and the lower Lands of Martha Myrick Dec^d which she inhe-
rited from John Myrick dec^d thence South forty degrees east, and a chopped
line to the rosen end branch thence down the various courses of said branch
to a red oak thence North eighty degrees West a long a new chopped line
dividing the said David Myrick other lands there purchased of the said
John Myrick and Elizabeth his wife to the beginning; also all the
right, title and Interest either by Law or equity which the said John My-
rick and Elizabeth his wife hath in or to that part of the Lands being
