

and whereas the said Rebecca cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said county to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Rebecca shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the Id Indenture which is hereto hereto annexed and we do command you to go personally to the said Rebecca and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her husband, and when you have examined her as aforesaid and received her acknowledgement of the said Indenture that you distinctly and openly certify us hereof, under your hand and Seal returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed to wit Sam^l Hillo clerk of our said court at the house the 21st day of December 1804
