

At a court held for the County of Southampton on the day of July  
1808 This Indenture was proven by the oaths of George Guly, Henry  
Thomas and Amos Stephenson three of the witnesses hereunto and sworn  
to be recorded —

This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1808 between Edmund  
Bishop and Betsey his wife of the one part and John Rochelle in  
the other Part both of the County of Southampton, Wiltshire that  
the said Edmund Bishop and wife for and in consideration of the  
sum of seven hundred Dollars current money of Virginia that  
is granted and by these Presents doth grant and confirm forever  
unto the said John Rochelle his heirs and assigns a certain  
Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty five  
acres be the same more or less with all houses out houses gardens  
orchards way water and water courses woods and underwoods mining  
minerals and all other profits and commodities thereto belong-  
ing and in any wise appertaining; To have and to hold the said  
premises with the appurtenances unto the said John Rochelle his  
heirs and assigns forever with the reversion and reversions, remain-  
ders and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof and every  
part and parcel thereof and the said Edmund Bishop and Betsey  
his wife for themselves their heirs executors and adm'rs do covenant  
and agree with the said John Rochelle his heirs and assigns  
in the following manner that is to say that the said Edmund  
Bishop and wife at the time of signing and sealing these presents  
is lawfully possessed of the said bargained premises and that  
the said is fully and clearly acquitted of and for all manner  
of incumbrances whatsoever and that the said Edmund Bishop  
and Betsey his wife doth hereby warrant and defend the  
hereby bargained premises against themselves their heirs  
against the lawful claim of all & every person and persons  
whatsoever and whomever unto the said John Rochelle his  
heirs and assigns forever — In witness whereof they the said  
Edmund Bishop and Betsey his wife have hereunto set their  
hands and seals the day and year above written —
