 ledge & do acquit the said Cordall Brantley her heirs exors & assigns
 have bargained sold & do by these presents for my self and my heirs
 forever sell & deliver unto him the said Cordall Brantley his heirs
 executors & assigns forever two certain tracts parcels or Dividends of Land
 lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia & on the South
 side of Cooper Swamp & being one third of fifty three acres of Land more
 or less, which said Land formerly belonged to Henry Brantley beginning
 at the corner a sassafras on the Cabin branch then down the said branch
 to Cooper Swamp then down the said Swamp to a small branch up
 the said branch to the corner of the fence, thence a South course up
 the fence to the corner thence west course to the beginning; To have
 & to hold the aforesaid Tracts of Land together with all privileges
 & Appurtenances thereunto Belonging to him the said Cordall
 Brantley his Heirs and assigns forever & that the said Land in
 clear of all Incumbrances of any nature whatsoever in Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this day and above

 that the said John Blaw & wife Elizabeth for and in consider-
 ation of the Sum of Hundred and seventy five Dollars to
 them in hand paid by the said Thomas Vaughan the receipt where-
 of they do hereby acknowledge they the said John Blaw & wife hath
 granted bargained & sold Alien Enfeoffed & by these presents doth
 grants bargain & sell alien Enfeoff & confirm unto the said
 Thomas Vaughan his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or
 parcel of Land containing Three Hundred & Seventy five acres
