

Simple state of and in Three hundred and seventy five acres of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and whereas the said Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give power to you to go to the said Elizabeth and receive the acknowledgement which she shall be willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do command you to go personally to the said Elizabeth and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her said husband & whether she is willing the said Indenture should be recorded in the Court of our said County, and when you have examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly certify thereof under your hands & Seals returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed Witness Sam^l Lello clerk of our Court at his office the 30th day of Jan^y 1808 and 3rd year of the Commonwealth —
