

This Indenture made this twentieth day of July in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and seven between Edwards Washington Tyler of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Pond of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edwards W. Tyler in order to secure the payment of one hundred and sixty dollars & seventy cents together with the interest to grow due thereon from the 1st day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and six of lawful money which he justly owes to Thomas Bidley senr. of the county aforesaid and for which said sum Thomas Gray of said County stands bound with the said Edwards W. Tyler now in order to secure the said Thomas Gray from any damage or Injury that he might sustain in consequence thereof and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Pond at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Edwards W. Tyler hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Pond his heirs executors administrators and assigns one negro man slave called and known by the name of Ferry and all the right title interest claim and demand of him the said Edwards W. Tyler of in or to the said negro man slave Ferry to have and to hold the said negro man slave Ferry unto him the said Samuel Pond his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless that said Samuel Pond shall as soon as he conveniently can after having been requested by the said Edwards W. Tyler or the said Thomas Gray to make sale of the said property, having first advertised the time and place of the sale thereof at the Court house of the County of Southampton giving ten days notice proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder for the best price that can be obtained in ready money and out of the monies arising from the sale, in the first place to pay and satisfy the costs of drawing and recording this Indenture and all the reasonable expenses and charges attending the same as aforesaid to be made and then the debt and interest and the residue of the monies if any shall be paid by the said Samuel Pond or his heirs executors administrators and assigns as to such person or persons by writing under his hand shall appoint and in
