of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joseph & his wife Elizabeth
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & ninety five pounds
as six shillings Current money of Virginia, already in hand paid
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given, granted bargai-
ned and sold, and by these presents do give, grant bargain and sell
unto the said Calvert his heirs & assigns, forever, Two certain tracts
or parcels of Land lying, and being in the said County of Southam-
pton as follows, one being the tract or parcel of Land that Benjamin
Johnson purchased of William Barnes & wife bearing date the 9th day
of October 1793 and is recorded in the County Court of Southampta
Containing one hundred & forty nine and eight tenths acres the boundaries
of which will fully appear by reference to said act. The other tract be-
ing the Land the said Benjamin Johnson purchased of Samuel
Moody & Lucy his wife and Wilson Holloman & Postey his wife by
Deed of Bargain & sale bearing date the 30th day of November 1799
and is likewise of record in said County of Southampton Containing forty
five and one half acres reference being had to the said deed, the bounds
