This Indenture made this 11th day of the 12th month 1807 Between Thomas Pittaw of the one part & Jacob Ricks of the other part witnesseth that the said Jacob Ricks for and in consideration of the sum of £ 2 23s which the said Jacob Ricks is justly indebted to the said Thomas Pittaw and han^t to desire to serve and pay to him and inwards thence he the said Jacob Ricks hath freely and voluntarily of his own accord and at his own request indentured himself unto the said Pittaw his heirs and assigns for the space of nine years and doth by these presents bind & indenture himself unto the said Thomas Pittaw his heirs and assigns for the term of nine years above said during all which time he is faithfully to serve the said Thomas Pittaw his heirs or assigns and obey all his lawful commands at all times by day or by night and to take care of all his property and acts for his interest at all times during the said term of time and the said Jacob Ricks doth furthermore authorise and empower the said Pittaw to administer correction at any time when he the said Ricks shall foolishly or impudently disobey said Pittaw or do neglect or abuse himself from said Pittaw in his business, now if the said Jacob Ricks shall fully & punctually comply with the above Indenture & every part thereof then at the end of nine years from the date hereof he is to be as fully and actually free as if this Indenture had never been Executed and the said Pittaw on his part is to find the said Ricks sufficient clothing Diet &c as is usual for those of his class.
