This Indenture made and entered into on this first day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eight by and between Albridgeon Jones and Polly Jones his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Griffin Stoth of the same county and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Albridgeon Jones and Polly Jones his wife for and in consideration of the intermarriage between the said Griffin Stoth and Margaret Bush Stoth his wife, who was Margaret Bush Jones daughter of the said Albridgeon Jones and of the sum of one hundred pounds to them in hand paid by the said Griffin Stoth at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) and from every part of which the said Griffin Stoth and all his legal representatives are forever exonerated & discharged, have given granted bargained sold alienated transferred enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain sell alienated transfer enfeoff and confirm to the said Griffin Stoth his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by Survey six hundred and Sixty seven acres and bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak standing in a swamp a corner tree on Albridgeon Hanes line thence down the said swamp (Westerly w¹) to the said Albridgeon Jones mill pond thence down the various courses of the said mill pond to the bridge over the saw mill race thence down the mill race to a pine a corner tree on Briggs line thence along Briggs line to a pine a corner tree on Spencer Pines line thence (N or nearly N) along a straight line of newly marked trees to the Beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land containing six hundred and Sixty seven acres and all and singular the tenements buildings houses out houses, orchards woods and other appurtenances therunto in any manner belonging and all the right title interest
