This Indenture made this twentieth day of March in the
year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eight—
Between Josiah Wick and Elizabeth his wife, of the County
of Southampton in the one part, and John Wright of the
Same County of the other part— Witnesseth that the
Said Josiah Wick & Eliza his wife for and in Consideration
of the sum of one hundred and ten pounds— to them in
hand paid: the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
given, granted, bargained & sold and by these presents do
give, grant bargain & sell unto the said John Wright
and his heirs one certain Lot of Land lying in the
town of Jerusalem Numbered three containing one half
an Acre: and Bounded as follows Viz- Beginning at
the South East Corner of Lot N^o two in the said Town
on the west Side of the main Street, running thence along
the line of N^o 2 two hundred and thirty seven feet six inches
to Notaway River thence down the said River eighty nine
feet one inch, to the N^o West corner of Lot Number
Six; thence along the north end of Lot N^o 6 to the North
west corner of Lot N^o 4 thence along the North Side of Lot
N^o 4 to the main Street— making in all from the river to the
Street two hundred and twenty feet four inches, thence along the
west Side of the main Street eighty five feet nine inches to
the beginning— To have and to hold the said Lot N^o 3
and all the appertinances thereunto belonging; to the said
John Wright and his heirs forever. And the said Josiah
Wick & Eliza his wife, their heirs Executors and Administrators
all rights and title to the said lot of land with its app-
ertinances, to him the said John Wright his heirs and
assigns, shall and will forever warrant and defend—
