This Indented Deed of bargain and sale made this 17th day
of December one thousand eight hundred and four between Shadrach Griffin
and Nancy his wife of Southampton County & State of Virginia of the
one part, and John Lee of the County & State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Shadrach Griffin and Nancy, his wife, for
and in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars by the said John Lee
to them in hands paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said Shadrach Griffin and Nancy his wife
doth hereby acknowledge themselves satisfied and paid they the said
Shadrach Griffin & Nancy his wife have granted bargained & sold
& confirmed unto doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said
John Lee his heirs and assigns forever one certain lot of lands to lying
and being in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid containing
one acre more or less bounded as follows: Beginning at a lightwood post
standing near the west corner of the dwelling House that the said
Shadrach Griffin now lives in, at a place called Old South given on
the west side of black water river thirty yards distant from the edge
of said black river running about a south east Direction to the edge
