

due & satisfaction of her dower & right of Dower in the Slaves of which her husband Arthur Boykin dec^d seized & possessed and the said Simon Boykin & Patsy Bridger do for themselves their heirs & assigns forever further last bequeath and in answer the use unto her the said Elizabeth Boykin as satisfaction for & in consideration of her right of Dower the following property to wit two negroes by name Tim & Micajah to have hold & enjoy during her natural life and no longer, also the following property viz a riding chain and harness, Two feather beds & furniture, two cows & calves two sows and pigs two ewes black Mare called Speck, ten Barnetts Corn 1/2 Dozen Windsor Chairs three flag bottom Dittos, one Chest, two wooden Tables & Candle Stand to have and to hold the aforesaid property to her the said Elizabeth Boykin her heirs and assigns forever - And the said Elizabeth Boykin doth for herself her heirs & assigns forever relinquish all her rights of Dower title & interest in the Slaves & all other personal estate whatever kind which she ~~was~~ had at the death of her husband Arthur Boykin - In witness whereof the parties to these presents do set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year above ^{written}
