

ninety seven Dollars & fifty Cents to them in hand paid by the said Morris, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they the said Kitchen & wife have granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant his & wife to sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm unto D<sup>r</sup> Morris or his heirs &c one certain tract or parcels of Land containing nineteen & a half Acres, be the same more or less, situate lying & being in the County of Southampton & bounded as follows vizt Beginning at a bay tree standing in a branch & in Morris's former line then down the main run of D<sup>r</sup> Branch the various courses sixty pole to a small premium tree in D<sup>r</sup> branch & in the mouth of another branch then up the run of D<sup>r</sup> branch nearly South 18 pole to a pine in D<sup>r</sup> Blows line then along D<sup>r</sup> Blows line to D<sup>r</sup> Morris's former corner post then along D<sup>r</sup> Morris's former line to the first Station - And also all trees wood underwoods commoners common of pasture profits commodities advantages emoluments & remittances whatsoever unto him the said Morris & his heirs &c To the sole proper use & behoof of him the said Morris & his Heirs &c To have and to all & singular the D<sup>r</sup> Branch above mentioned belonging or any ways appertaining or in or upon the same growing happening or arising & also all the estate right title interest claim & demand whatsoever of they the said Kitchen & wife of in & to the said premises & every part thereof unto him the said Morris his heirs &c against themselves & their Heirs & against all & every other person & persons whatsoever shall and will warrant & forever defend by these presents - In witness whereof the said William Kitchen & wife Sarah have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year first above written
