This Indenture made this 15th day of March: one thousand
 Eight hundred and eight Between William Finch and Dorothy Fin-
 ch his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of
 the one part and James Williams an Orphan Solomon Deloach Parker
 and Joseph Henry Parker Orphans of Frederick Parker Deceased of
 the other part - Witnesseth that the said William Finch and Dorothy
 Finch his wife for other good causes an considerations but more especially
 for and in consideration of the sum of thirty three pounds of good and
 Lawful Money, of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James
 W. Parker Solomon D. Parker and Joseph H. Parker orphans of Freder-
 ick Parker Deceased as aforesaid before the sealing and delivering of these
 presents the net whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof & therefrom
 do forever acquit release and discharge the said Orphans and thereupon do
 give grant convey and confirm and by these presents have given granted con-
 veyed and confirmed unto the said Orphans a certain tract or parcel of
 Land lying and being in the County aforesaid, containing Forty six Acres
 be the same more or less and bounded as follows to-wit: Beginning at
 the mouth of little Branch at the Spring Swamp betwixt the said
 Finch and the lands of Solomon Deloach Deceased thence up the said
 Branch to a red oak upon a mast tree at the head of the said Branch
 thence along a line of marked trees to a black gum or cypress tree in
 the great branch thence the various Courses of the said Branch it
 being a line betwixt the said Finch and Frederick Parker Deceased to
 the mouth of the said branch at the Spring Swamp aforesaid
 thence Down the various Courses of the said Swamp to the beginning
 with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging, the now
 and hereafter heirs and assigns of the said Orphans to have and to hold
 the said tract or parcel of Land and all and singular the premises
 thereby granted with appurtenances herunto belonging unto the said
