This Indenture made this twenty Third day of February  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eight between  
 William Charles and Edith Charles his wife of the County of Southam-  
 pton and parish of Netoway of the one part and Joseph Denson  
 of the same County and parish of the other part. Witnesseth that  
 the said William Charles and Edith his wife for and in considera-  
 tion of the just and full sum of Thirteen dollars and fifty Cents by  
 the said Joseph Denson to them the said William Charles and  
 Edith his wife in hand paid before the unsealing and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof they the said William Charles  
 and Edith his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit  
 and discharge the said Joseph Denson his heirs and assigns by  
 themselves therewith fully and intirely satisfied Contented and  
 paid that the said William Charles & Edith his wife hath  
 granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over  
 delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant barg-  
 ain sell enfeoff deliver and confirm unto the said Joseph  
 Denson & to his heirs and assigns a certain tract and parcel of  
 Land lying and being in the County of Southampton & parish of  
 Netoway aforesaid containing by a late Survey Six acres be the  
 same more or less and bounded as follows to wit, beginning at  
 a black Oak in the said Densons line near the road thence along  
 the said Densons old Line crossing the road & running the var-  
 ious courses of the said Densons old Line to a red oak standing
