To all to whom these presents shall come know ye that I William
Hart the Elder of the state of Virginia and County of Southampton
for the love good will and affection that I bear unto my Daughter
Temperance Harrison of the place aforesaid have given granted and
Confirmed and by these presents writing do fully freely absolutely give
grant and confirm unto my said Daughter Temperance Harrison
her heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcels of Land lying and
being in the State of Virginia and County of Southampton and on
the west side of Mattaway river Containing by estimation forty acres
be the same more or less. it is bounded as followeth beginning at
the mouth of a gut on East side of the manner plantation where
the said William Hart the elder liveth thence up the various courses
of said gut to a red oak a corner tree between Jas^d Harrison
and the said William Hart the elder thence east to a corner tree
in the said James Harrison's line thence along the said James Harrison's
line to a maple standing at the edge of Mattaway river thence up the
various courses of said river to the beginning including forty acres
Land Together with half of a Mill across the above mentioned gut
and the remainder and remainders reversion and reversion's rents
issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title Interest claim
and demand whatsoever of me the said William Hart the elder and
my heirs and of in or to the same or any part thereof. To have and
to hold the said Land with the half of a mill above mentioned with
the appertinances unto my said Daughter Temperance Harrison her
heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use benefit and behoof
her the said Temperance Harrison her heirs and assigns forever In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this 24th day Dec^r 1808
