This Indenture made this twenty first day of November in the year of Christ Eighteen hundred and seven, between Jonas Bryant & Silvia Bryant his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Barrett of the same County on the other part Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the Sum of one hundred and sixty one Dollars and twenty five Cents in hand paid have bargained and sold, and by these presents, do grant bargain, sell, alien, give, and confirm unto him the said Benjamin Barrett his heirs and assigns a Certain Tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a persimmon tree in the long branch, thence running Northwesterly one hundred poles to Mial's line on the road, thence along said line to Richard Williams line thence along said Williams as it meanders to a white oak in said Barretts line, thence along said Barretts line ten poles to the long branch, thence down said branch as it meanders to the beginning, Containing Thirty two and one fourth Acres be the same more or less; To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto him the said Benjamin Barrett, his heirs and assigns forever. And they the said Jonas Bryant and Silvia his wife doth by these presents, quit claim warrant and will forever defend, unto him the said Barrett his heirs and assigns, all right, title, property and Interest in and to the said Land and its appertinences.
