This Indenture made this fourth day of January One thousand eight hundred and eight, Between Benjamin and Faithy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Edwin Reese of the aforesaid County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty pounds to me in hands paid by the d^r Edwin Reese at or before the sealing and delivering these presents whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enforf and Confirm unto the said Edwin Reese a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of notes way River and in the parish St. Luke and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a pine in Drury Wallers line running northwards binding on said Barham to a red oak at the head of the cabin branch thence down said branch to the fork, thence up the west prong to a pine a corner of Benj^m W. Johnstons and Mary Jarrell, thence along the said Jarrells line to black gum standing in the Indian branch at the mouth of the white oak meadow thence up said meadow to the fork, thence up the east prong of said meadow to a pine standing in the head of the said meadow thence to a Spanish oak in Drury Wallers line, thence along the Drury Wallers line to the road thence down the road to a hickory a corner of Drury Waller thence down the said line to a white oak another corner of Drury Waller thence down said Wallers line to the beginning, With all the improvements thereto belonging, And that I the said Benjamin Barham for myself and my heirs executors assigns do warrant and ever defend the aforesaid tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and ninety eight acres to the same more or less unto the said Edwin Reese him and his heirs forever, against all and every person or persons whom may hereafter any pretensions of a claim or claims by or through me to the aforesaid premises; In witness we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year above written -
