This Indenture made this 31st day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven between Henry Brown and Lucy his wife of the State of North Carolina and County of Wake of the one part and William Boykin of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the other part; Witnesseth that the said Henry Brown and wife Lucy for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ten dollars and fifty five cents to them in hand paid by the said William Boykin the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they the said Henry Brown and wife have granted bargained and sold Alien Enfeoffed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell Alien Enfeoff and forever Confirm one certain tract or parcel of Land Containing Sixty three Acres and one sixth be the same more or less lying and being in Southampton County and bounded as follows Beginning at a large poplar in a line Hollomans line thence No 11 to dit pole a white oak in said line thence N. 69 W. fifty seven pole to the main run of Swack Swamp thence thence various Courses of D. Swamp to the mouth of the Spring branch thence up the various Courses of D. branch to Hollan Browns line thence No 43 E. fifty three pole to the first Station and also all Trees Woods underwoods Commons Common of pasturage profits commodities advantages Emoluments and hindertments whatsoever to the said William Boykin his heirs &c. To have all or Singular the said Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof unto said Boykin his heirs &c. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said Boykin his heirs &c. and against the said Brown and his wife and heirs forever who do warrant and defend all rights title of said Lands unto the D. Boykin his heirs &c. In Witness whereof the said Henry Brown and wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their Seal the day and year first above written
