This Indenture made this fourteenth day of February in the year  
of Christ one thousand eight hundred and eight between Britain Bryant  
of the County of Southampton of the first part Richard Blunt of the  
same County, of the second part, and James Gee administrator of John  
Norfleet dec<sup>d</sup> also of the same County of the third part Whereas the  
said Britain Bryant has taken upon himself to answer and account  
for a debt due by his father Nathan Bryant, upon a judgment aga-  
inst him by the executors of Cardall Norfleet, obtained in the district  
court of Suffolk, amounting to two hundred and thirty two pounds  
sixteen shillings and eight pence, current money of Virginia, for  
which amount the said Britain Bryant hath granted to the said  
James Gee, administrator as aforesaid his bond, bearing even date with  
these presents; and whereas the said Britain is willing to secure the pay-  
ment of the aforesaid debt with the Interest arising thereon; Now this  
Indenture witnesseth that the said Britain Bryant, in Consideration of  
the premises, and of the further sum of five Shillings to him in hand  
paid by the said James Gee administrator as aforesaid, the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these  
present doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Richard Blunt his  
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land, in the County  
of Southampton aforesaid, on the north side of Tarrara Creek and contain-  
ing three hundred acres, more or less; it being the same land which was  
sold and conveyed by Cardall Norfleet and wife to the said Nathan  
Bryant together with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders,  
rights, issues and services thereof; and also all the estates, rights, title and  
property claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Britain Bryant  
of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and of  
every part thereof To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel  
of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Richard  
Blunt his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him  
the said Richard Blunt his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
Britain Bryant, against the claim and demands of all persons whatsoever  
the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with the
