

any stuff &c in any part of the land for the use of the plantation; but may not clear any other lands except that above mentioned nor commit waste on the lands by burning the lightwood or using the pines or other timbers in any other way than above stipulated - they are to keep at the stable door or some other suitable place a tott in which they are to cause to be collected and pressed all the straw fodder trash and other litter suitable for the purpose of making manure, which when sufficiently trod and rolled they are to spread in and sow into some part of the land - And lastly that it shall and may be lawful for the said Henry Bishop and John Bishop paying the rents herein before reserved, and performing the covenants and agreements herein before mentioned or contained and which in their parts and behalfs are or ought to be paid, done and performed, peaceably and quietly, to have hold, occupy possess and enjoy the said premises hereby leased, with the appurtenances, during the term of nine years, hereby granted without any molestation, or interruption whatsoever, of or by him the said Jacob Darden Curator as aforesaid, or any person who may succeed to the care of the premises, or his or their assigns or of or by any person or persons, lawfully or equitably claiming or to claim, from, by or under him, their, or any of them - except the lease should terminate, by any of the means herein before mentioned - In Witness whereof they the said Jacob Darden Curator for William Ennill nephew of Mills Ennill decd and Henry Bishop and John Bishop have herunto set their hands and seals this day and year first before -
