This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March Eighty  
hundreds and Eight between William Blow and Eliza his wife of

pounds Six Shillings to him in hand paid by the said John Under-  
wood hath bargained and sold at end Enteoff and by this present  
doth grant bargain and sell alien and Convey unto the said  
Underwood one certain tract or parcel of Land containing thirty  
three Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows  
Beginning at a pine in the Lee Lane Branch south 16 degrees 87  
pole south 31 East 1 1/2 pole to a corner hickory in the said Under-  
wood line thence S 78 E 16 pole to a corner white oak on the side of a  
small branch thence a line of marked Trees S 81 W 8 pole then  
84 degrees W 20 pole to another small branch thence up the said  
branch due South 64 pole thence South 19 W 26 pole then due  
South 47 pole to a corner turkey oak in the said Underwoods line  
thence due west 34 pole to a white oak near a small brook  
in John Johnsons line - thence North 50 east 18 pole to a new low  
red oak thence north 18 W 68 pole to a low art off white oak in the  
head of the branch leading from the buck pond thence down the  
various Courses of the said Branch to the mouth where it empties into  
the Lee Lane Branch thence up the said branch to the beginning  
also all trees underwoods profits and advantages whatsoever to the  
said John Underwood belonging or any ways appertaining to  
the same also the reversion remainder life to the said present  
and of every part and parcel thereof and also all the estate of  
title interest claims and demands whatsoever of them the said  
William Blow and Eliza his wife of and into the said premises  
of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said premises

heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend of the
