This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of June in the year of Christ eighteen hundred and eight between John Johnson and Sally Jones on his wife Jordan Barrett and Elizabeth Barrett his wife all of the County of Southampton of the one part, and James Worrell of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred and ninety four Dollars in hand paid have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said James Worrell, his Heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the mouth of Anders Branch, thence running up the said branch to a pine standing in the head of said branch thence along to a pine a corner in the said James Worrell's line, thence along said Worrell's line to a dogwood a corner in Jordan Barretts line, thence along the said Barretts line to a pine a corner in John Jagers line, thence along the said Jagers line to the said house swamp, thence down the said swamp to the beginning containing ninety Eighty and one half acres to the same more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of Land unto him
