The Commonwealth of Virginia to William Blaw and Henry Blaw Gentlemen Justices of the peace Whereas the said John Johnson and Sally his wife have by their certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated the 21 day of June 1808 conveyed unto James Warrell of the same County of Southampton the fee simple estate of and in ninety eight and one half acres of land more or less and whereas the said Sally and Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Sally and Elizabeth shall be willing to make before you of the foregoing aforesaid contents in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do command you to go personally to the said Sally and Eliza and examine them privately and apart from their husbands whether they have executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of their husbands and whether they are willing the said deed should be recorded in the County Court of our said County and when you have so taken their acknowledgments of the said Indenture that you distinctly certify us thereof under your hands and seals returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed to the Clerk of our said Court at his office this 5th of July 1808 and in the 33rd year of the Commonwealth

Agreeable to the within Commission to us directed we have with us the said Sally Johnson and Elizabeth Barritt and examined them separately apart from their husbands and they are willing that their relinquishment should be recorded in the County Court of Southampton given under our hands and seals this 8th day of July 1808
