This Indenture made this 13th day of August in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and eight Between Thomas Newson Pilgrim
in Vick John Barnes and Isaac M. Brooks of the County of Kent
of the one part and Lewis Ward of the said County of the second part
Witnesseth that that the said Thomas Newson Pilgrim Vick John Barnes
Isaac M. Brooks in obedience to a decree of Southampton assize Court
after giving legal notice of the time and place of Sale, have set up to the
highest bidder the Land and plantation whereon Nathan Ward formerly
lived which was conveyed to Holliday Revell by mortgage to secure the
payment of a debt due the Deceased Sir Charles Ward and ordered
to be sold under virtue of the said mortgage deed which Land was bid
of by Lewis Ward for the sum of one hundred and ninety pounds six shil-
lings and six pence. In consideration of the above sum of one hundred
and ninety pounds six and six pence (one the said Thomas Newson
Pilgrim Vick John Barnes and Isaac M. Brooks) to us in hand paid
by the said Lewis Ward the receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge both
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by
the said Lewis Ward his heirs and assigns forever the above mentioned
Land and plantation of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and
on the South side of the Testoway River containing by estimation one hundred
and twenty five and one half Acres be the same more or less and bounded
as follows beginning at a pine a corner in the Cypress Swamp thence a
long a line of marked trees to a dead pine a corner in Jo Wards line
thence along the said Jo Wards line to a pine a corner tree between Holla-
day Revell Jo Ward and Nathan Ward dead thence along the said
said line to a pine in the head of the Saw branch thence down the
