

Beginning at a gum a Corner made at the Division of the Land
now a Corner of the two parties running thence up the various
Cours of the Millpond to the Indigo Branch, thence the various
Cours of S. Branch to the Wood Spring Branch thence along S.
Branch to a Small pine A. Corner in Hardy Brantleys line thence
along a Straight line to Gilliam's Swamp thence along S. Swamp
to A Spanish oak a new Corner of the Dividing line between the
parties then along that Dividing line to the first Station - With
all Houses and Houses Edifices Buildings yards gardens Orchards
Waters and Watercourses profits & hereditaments, and appurtenances
to the said Lands belonging or in any wise appertaining and all
the profits thereof. To have and to hold the said Plantation
tract or parcel of Land forever, and the said David M. Edmunds
for himself his heirs Executors administrators doth hereby Covenant and
grants to and with the said Martha Edmunds her heirs & assigns
forever, and by these presents doth forever Defend unto the said
Martha Edmunds against the rights of any other person claiming
or Demanding the Same - In Witness whereof the said David
